*All rates are for full time care (Monday through Friday).

**Families of more than one child will receive a discount of 10% per child.

Registration/Supply Fees:

There will be a non-refundable registration/supply fee per child due each year. The fee is \$30 per child for one child, \$50 for two children, and an additional \$10 per child after that. This fee allows up to buy art and teaching supplies.

Policies:

1. Hours: The Children's Nest is open from 6:30am to 5:45pm. All children MUST be picked up by 5:45pm, or a late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed.
2. Payment Deadline: Payments are due by Wednesday of the current week. If payment is received after Wednesday at 5:45pm, a \$10.00 late fee will be assessed.
3. Returned Checks: There will be a \$35.00 fee for all returned checks.
4. Payment Reduction: There will be no reduction in payment when The Children's Nest is closed. There is also no reduction in payment when a child is absent (aside from the two given vacation weeks).
5. Vacation: After three months, each child will be granted two tuition-free vacation weeks per year. These weeks must be a full Monday-Friday week and the child must be absent all days. All vacation weeks will reset in September. Vacation weeks may not be carried over or transferred. Please let The Children's Nest know of all vacations in advance.
6. Illness: If a child is sent home due to illness, or has been kept home for illness at the parent's discretion, they may NOT return to The Children's Nest the next day. This is for the health and safety of our children and staff.
